+ CV in other formats is acceptable, but it needs to clearly illustrate the qualifications of the nominee following the selection criteria. CV that do not address this criteria may significantly reduce the Nominee’s chance to be elected.

+ The Nominator is encouraged to share the CV template with the Nominee to fill out and attach the CV in the final submission. CVs sent to the Academy directly by the Nominee will not be accepted.

+ The bibliography document should be submitted separately by the Nominator.

List in reverse chronological order the presentations you have delivered that are relevant to Academy Fellowship, starting with the most recent one. Limit to 200 words.

**E. RECENT FUNDING**

List in reverse chronological order the funding you received in the past 5 years, starting with the most recent one. If applicable, briefly describe current major grants and the nature of the funded project. Limit to 250 words.

**F. SERVICE & OUTREACH**

Describe the most significant contributions that you made to the field of microbial sciences. Include major national leadership positions in professional societies and boards – current or past. Limit to 200 words.

**G. EDUCATION AND MENTORING**

Briefly describe what you have done to teach, mentor and inspire the next generation of microbiologists. You may include mentorship of your own graduate students and fellows, but you are also encouraged to include activities that are exceptional, unusual, or creative, activities that are outside your own institution, and/or activities that promote equity, diversity and inclusion. Limit to 200 words.
